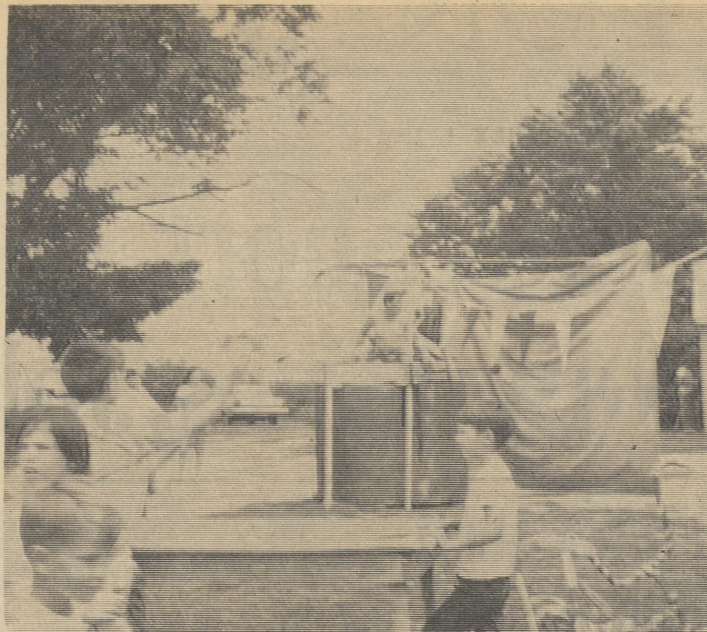

Two Episcopal Clergymen Accept Call To Churches In Sussex County

Two new Episcopal clergymen have accepted calls to churches in Sussex County as announced recently by the Rt. Rev. William H. Mead, bishop of Delaware.

The Rev. Edward Evan Martin, Jr., recently ordained to the Diaconate by Bishop Mead is a native of Delaware and is now in residence in the vicarage of St. John Baptist Episcopal Church in Milton.

The Rev. Joseph Emerson James on the first of July will move into the rectory of Christ Church, Milford. He will assume services at Christ Church in August. He has been rector of St. Mark's Church in Teaneck, N. J., since 1965 and has served on the Standing Liturgical Com-

mission of the Diocese of Newark and as Episcopal Chaplain of Holy Name Hospital of Teaneck as well as a member of the Chaplaincy Committee of Englewood Hospital.

James attended public in Cambridge, Md., and received degrees from the University of Maryland and General Theological Seminary, New York City. He has served churches in Easton, Denton and Elkton, Md., having been ordained to the Diaconate in Christ Church, Cambridge in 1955 and ordained to the Priesthood in Christ Church, Easton at the end of that year.

James is married to the former Margaret Estelle Newnam of Easton and they have three children, Margaret, 8; Deborah Lynn, 11; and Joseph Jr., 13.

Martin attended Wilmington schools and graduated with honors from Penn. Military College in 1964. He attended Temple University School of Law, was employed by the DuPont Company for three years, and was gradu-

ed from the Virginia Theological Seminary this spring. He was selected as outstanding senior of the Class of 1971 receiving the Remington Cup for athletic and scholastic achievement. Married to the former Christianna Radcliffe Cassidy of Wilmington they have one son, Edward, III, 2 1/2. Both the Rev. and Mrs. Martin's parents reside in Wilmington.
