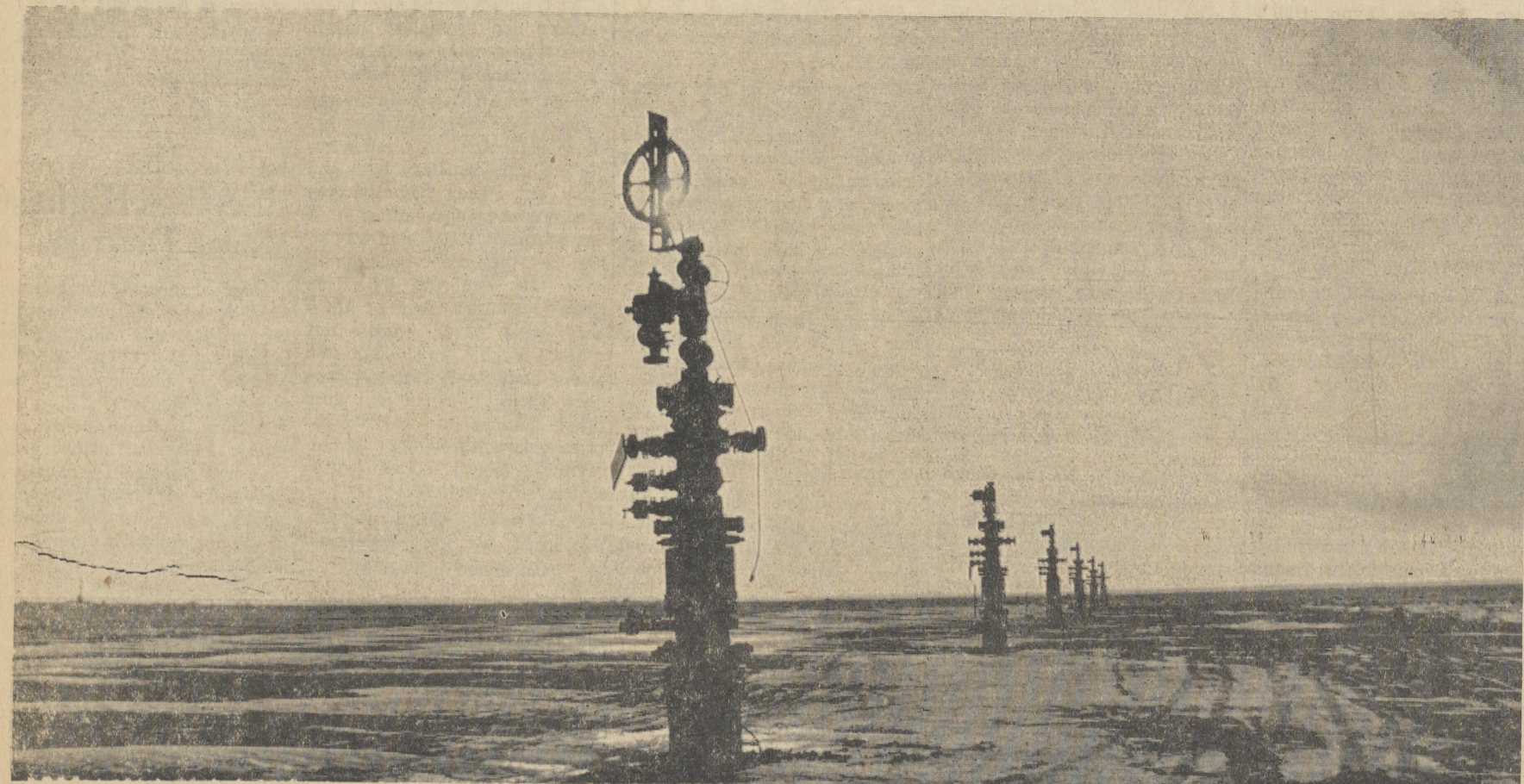

**Chicken As You Like It**

It wouldn't be the Delmarva Chicken Festival without its renowned landmark, the Giant Fry Pan. Measuring 10 feet in diameter, this oversized skillet made its first appearance in 1950. Since that time it has been used at 23 festivals where it has cooked more than 200,000 pieces of chicken.

The famous fry pan is now in Salisbury, Md., being prepared for its annual appearance at the 26th Delmarva Chicken Festival, June 15-17, at the Wicomico Youth and Civic Center. Members of the Salisbury Lions Club

under the chairmanship of Paul Briddell, will be in charge of the fry pan operation.

According to Briddell, platters will be on sale to the public for a cost of \$1.75. The menu will include 1/4 fried chicken, baked beans, applesauce and rolls.

For those who prefer their chicken barbecued, members of the Salisbury Jaycees will be working to accommodate this preference. Barbecued chicken, prepared over the open coals, will be featured on a platter which includes potato chips and rolls. Cost is \$1.75.

Fried and barbecued concessions will be operating between 11 a.m. and 9 p.m., Friday and Saturday, June 15 and 16, Sun., June 17, serving will take place between 11 a.m. and 6 p.m.

**Milk In Your Diet**

June is dairy month, and it's also a good time to remember how important dairy products can be to adequate nutrition.

Milk and milk products are a very efficient source of certain minerals, especially calcium, says Miss Marguerite Krackhardt, extension nutrition specialist at the University of Delaware. It is also a source of vitamins and high quality protein, all of which are essential to sound health.

Milk has a mild, but slightly sweet flavor and combines nicely with many different flavors, seasonings and other ingredients, so it should be easy to find some way of using milk to please any member of the family.

For example, cottage cheese flavored with curry is a tasty accompaniment to cold cuts of meat or fresh fruit. It's a marvelous luncheon diet for the weight watcher or anyone in a hurry.

Milk shakes are delicious snack foods, and there's no reason why they can't be used for breakfast. If fresh fruit or fruit juices are used for flavoring, that's even more nutritious.

When buying milk and milk products, be sure to purchase top quality items and store them properly at home. Milk is very susceptible to flavor changes if not kept chilled and covered.

Whole or skimmed evaporated milk and non-fat dry milk are nutritionally equivalent to fluid milk, and are usually less expensive.

**Keeping Employees On Farms**

If Delaware farmers want to keep good employees, they will need to make some improvements of paying. More and more farm employees are being drawn away from the farm by attractive jobs in industry, and farmers must change if they want to meet this competition, says W.T. McAllister, extension agricultural economist at the University of Delaware. He adds that Michigan State University economists have some suggestions on how this can be done.

Farmers should set a specific limit on the number of hours they expect employees to work. They can justify longer hours than most industry jobs require because most farm employees don't have to spend an hour or more driving to and from work every day. However, if the farmer wants employees to work more than the specified number of hours, he should pay overtime to get it.

In the long run, paying a good wage is a better way to attract and keep employees than offering cash bonuses. Some employees may appreciate bonuses; others may just wonder why they aren't larger.

Farmers should be sure employees understand the value of the fringe benefits they receive. Include a form listing the approximate value of fringe benefits with every pay check.

If housing is provided for employees, be sure to have some understanding about it. Employees should not be put in the position of having to ask for improvements, as they are likely to feel they are asking for a gift. It's also important to keep wives of employees happy, and attractive housing is a good way to do this.

Hospital medical insurance for employees is a good investment for the farmer who wants to keep good help.

Disability insurance is a good way to provide sick leave. The employer's costs for the insurance are tax deductible, and the benefits are tax deductible for the employee. Other benefits such as life insurance and retirement income should also be considered.

To compete with industry for workers, farmers must make benefits for farm work as attractive as benefits in industrial work. So they should sell farm work to individuals who like rural living. Improved personnel management is one of the best ways to keep employees on the farm.

**Del. River And Bay Authority News**

Anticipated heavier traffic starting June 30 will be accommodated with a third bayliner joining the Cape May-Lewes Ferry service, according to Theodore C. Bright, general manager.

The third vessel will be placed into service each weekend throughout July and August and the first weekend in September, Bright announced.

Weekend departures for the third liner from Cape May are at 12 noon and 4 p.m. DST, and from Lewes, Delaware, at 2 and 6 p.m., DST. These crossings are in addition to the regular summer schedule which includes a two-vessel operation from May 25 through Sept. 16, according to Bright.

The supplemental crossings schedule is: June 30; July 1 and 4; July 7 and 8; July 14 and 15; July 21 and 22; July 28 and 29; Aug. 3, 4, 5 and 6; Aug. 10, 11, 12 and 13; Aug. 17, 18, 19 and 20; Aug. 24, 25, 26 and 27; Sept. 1 and 2.

The Cape May-Lewes Ferry, operated by the Delaware River and Bay Authority, crosses the 17 miles of Delaware Bay between Cape May and Lewes on a year-round schedule and is the Seaward Route of the famed Ocean Hiway.

**State Police Recruit Class Begins Training**

The 36th Delaware State Police recruit class began training Mon., June 4, with 34 recruits in residence at the State Police Training Academy in Dover.
