

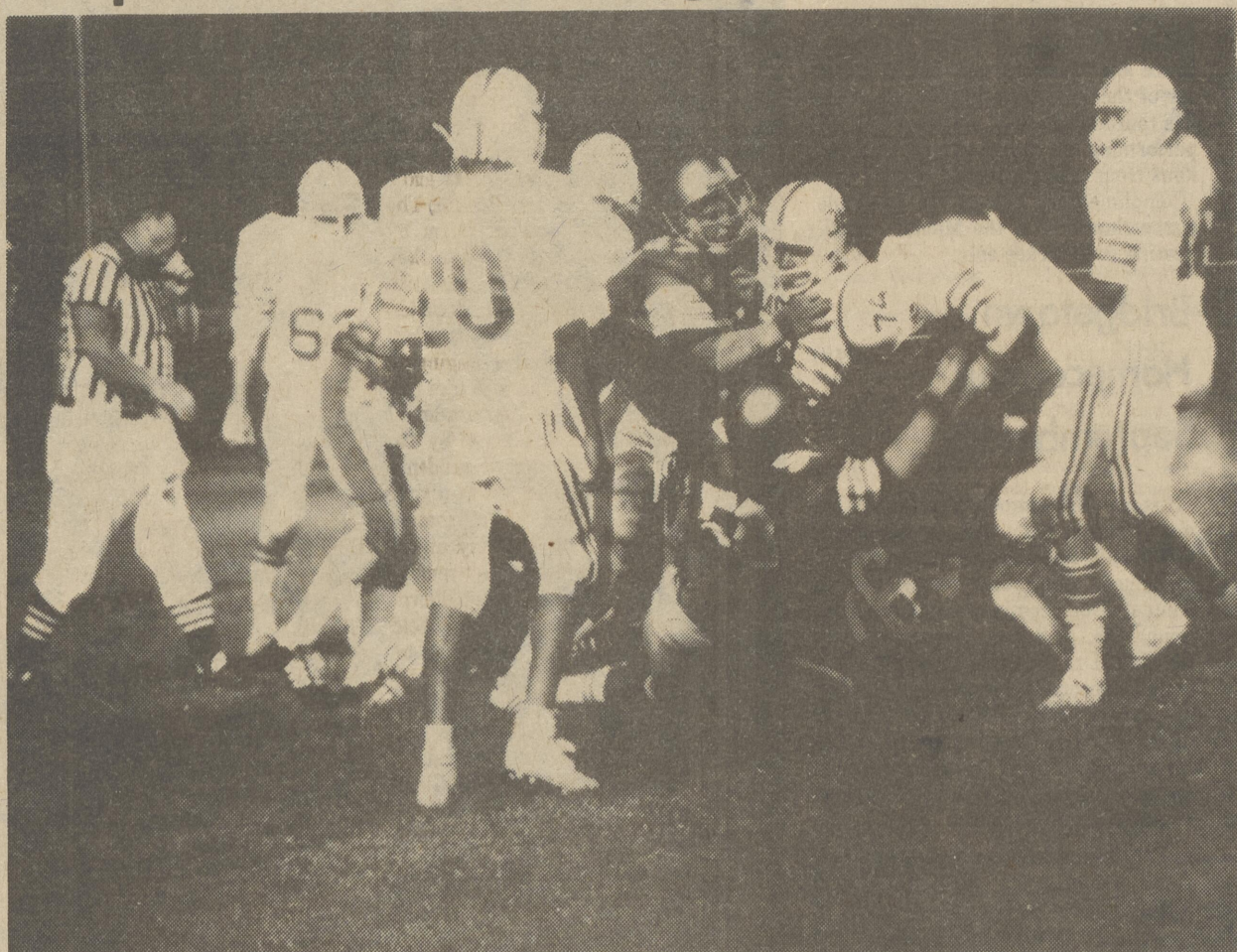

### 25th Lake Forest Invitational Results

Dover, N.J. was team winner of the 25th Annual Lake Forest Cross-Country Invitational, Division II, held at Killen's Pond State Park on Saturday. The New Jersey team has competed in this four-state meet several times and finally came up with a victory. McKean High was second followed by Cape Henlopen, Woodbridge, Lake Forest, Laurel, Seaford, Smyrna and Oxford, PA. Host Lake Forest has had a string of mishaps, which have sidelined or hindered several top runners. Mike Grogan was hospitalized after being hit on the head by a bottle, thrown from a passing car, while Mike was on a training run. Danny Donovan, top Spartan in a recent three way team scrimmage, like Grogan couldn't run in the Invitational. Danny dropped a battery on his foot. Mike Melvin, who had the highest 1981 ranking of all current Spartans, did not run for a year, since then and started running only recently, when his problem was finally diagnosed correctly by Roger Hunt, Delaware State College trainer. He'll need a few weeks to get in shape. Mike managed an incredible 18.50 for

three miles. Danny Haines, #1 Spartan lost some training time because of a gym class injury, but returned to post an 18.01 clocking, which equalled his personal course record. Robby Manaraze was next for Lake Forest, followed by Jerry Mosley, who had his best local clocking yet. Bob Smith who is the third harrier, by that name in 25 years of winning cross country teams here, ran very well. Smith ran for Chipman in junior high a couple of years back and was impressive in his varsity debut. Chris Caskey and Lafayette Bell ran well also. Pam Pierce led the Spartan girls in the Division II girls race won by Padua Academy. Pam had a personal best of 21.32 for three miles. Tara Gladden, Debbie Jester, Becky Brown Ann Irby and Maria Kazlauskas, all ran well for Lake Forest, which has a chance to win the Henlopen girls title. Brown lowered her time by 2 minutes plus. In jayvee competition Billy Haggerty, Mike Mosley, Tom Nelligan and John Caskey were the top locals. Jerry Mosley and Tara Gladden were selected by Coach Jim Blades as "Harriers of the Week."

## Spartans sack Eagles, 12-0



Last week, before the Spartans season opener, Lake Forest's Jim Fleming was worried about his defense. Several seasoned players were out with injuries. He need not have worried. The Spartan defense sacked veteran Smyrna quarterback, Macky Traubado eleven times on the way to a 12-0 victory over the Smyrna Eagles. Both Spartan touchdowns came in the first half, one with 6:15 to go in the initial quarter when quarterback Brian Gladden plunged a final four yards to cross the goal line. The second was the result of a 38 yard pass play from Gladden to Brian Hudson. The Eagles took the initiative in the third quarter with a drive that was stopped by the Spartan defense inside the one yard line. Smyrna never threatened after that. A down note came in the fourth quarter as Smyrna's quarterback Macky Traubado suffered an injury which will bench him for four or five games.

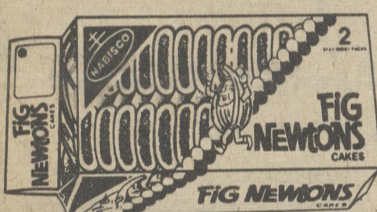

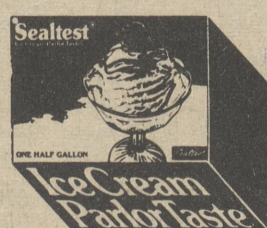
